



## **Director of Services and Community Development**

Community Living Haldimand (CLH) is a non-profit organization that serves the County of Haldimand, in the province of Ontario. The organization provides supports and services to approximately 160 adults who have an intellectual/developmental disability. Services include residential, supported independent living, community participation, and Passports.

Community Living Haldimand has an exciting opportunity for a new Director role to help grow the organization to meet the current and changing needs of people requiring support within Haldimand and to support achievement of the organizations key strategic directions.

Reporting to the Executive Director, the position will focus on the strategic elements of the organization. This includes expanding service and partnership opportunities, overall planning, development, community relations, quality assurance and risk management at the strategic level.

Working collaboratively with the management team, the role is responsible to initiate and lead new community service initiatives and programs including non-traditional and fee based services, family engagement activities as well as provide service oversight and input into the development of staff knowledge and skills.

Successful candidates will have a Master's Degree in a Human Services/Health Care field or combination of equivalent education and work experience. Minimum 8-10 years of progressive work experience, with several in a senior leader capacity. Candidates that bring knowledge and experience with individuals with developmental disabilities and complex needs and mental health issues are of particular interest.
