- Requires knowledge that is usually acquired by achieving the equivalent of a College Diploma. Knowledge and related experience of at least three months providing direct support for people with developmental disabilities and mental health aspects.
- Current First Aid and CPR certificate and Non Violent Crisis Intervention certificate.
- Personal resilience combined with a compassionate, insightful perspective fostering a steady commitment to the individuals' emotional, behavioural and mental health profiles.
- Knowledge and experience in assisting in the development and implementation of Behavioural Support Plans in co-operation with support networks.
- Show initiative in planning, organizing and implementing activities that are meaningful to the person, utilizing community supports where possible.
- Supports will adhere to Community Living Owen Sound and District's Mission, Vision and Core Values
- Ability to work and contribute in a team atmosphere
- Demonstrate a positive work performance
