Community Living St. Catharines' Support Coordinators provide a wide range of supports to persons with an intellectual disability aged 18-years and older in the absence of natural family supports, friends, and community. This program provides 24-hour support staff within a group home setting.

Community Living St. Catharines is seeking motivated, ambitious, team players who enjoy helping others to reach their goals through positive role modeling and person centred thinking.

### Responsibilities:

- ❖ Actively provide direct care for persons with an intellectual disability through assistance, guidance, goal planning and life skills coaching
- ❖ Provide personal care, health care and community access while being familiar with routines and activities
- ❖ Assist with household duties, shopping, and meal preparation
- ❖ Ensure the safety and well-being of each person at all times
- ❖ Provide coverage for afternoons, evenings and weekend shifts, overnight shifts may be required. Scheduled 0-24 hours a week, plus on call opportunities

### Qualifications:

- ❖ Completion of a two-year related Community College Diploma or University degree
- ❖ Experience in a related field
- ❖ Valid "G" Driver's License with \$1 Million Liability Insurance
